

GUIDELINES FOR CRAFTERS

The Crafters Jury Committee evaluates all new products to be sold at market, through a jury review, to ensure the craft meets the market product guidelines and criteria.

The craft review is based on the following market standards:

1. The craft must be handmade, grown or gathered by the seller.
2. The hand-crafted components must dominate any commercial components used and any commercial components must be transformed in a way that makes the work unique.
3. The craft must be of original, unique work or design.
4. The craft must be of high quality and meet basic expectations of product life, function and safety.
5. At the Rogue Valley Growers & Crafters Market: “The maker is the seller.” Except for reasonable breaks throughout the day, the maker or partner who actually participates in the making of the craft will be present.
6. Every craft member is required to declare on their membership application that any craft sold is of their own creation.
7. All members, new or returning, must submit new crafts to the Crafters Jury for review before they are permitted to sell it at market.
8. It must be determined that any new craft would be an asset to the market prior to acceptance.
9. The seller must be involved with the on-going design and production of the craft.
10. All new crafters will be asked to make a brief presentation of their work to the Crafters Jury as part of the approval process, prior to being able to sell at market.
11. Presentations must be made to the Crafters Jury. Time and location to be announced.
12. Upon setup of new crafters’ first day at market, a committee or board member will visit your booth to review your product, booth presentation, and answer any questions you may have about the market.
13. Crafts for all new vendors are to be hand made by the seller and be made from agriculture products.
